



Truckstar Festival 2022 regulations

Truckstar Festival is Europe's largest trucking event. It is renowned for its uniquely warm and easy going atmosphere. As a participant of Truckstar Festival, you represent the trucking industry and its image. In addition you contribute to the good atmosphere of the event. We would very much appreciate it for you to always be aware of these two things, so as to turn Truckstar Festival into a fantastic event, both for yourself and all the weekend's visitors.

To make sure Truckstar Festival has a happy future, a set of regulations has been put together, applying to every participant of the event.

Own risk

Entering the Festival grounds happens at everybody's own risk. Truckstar and/or TT Circuit can never be held liable for any damage to vehicles, persons or property.

Entry wristbands

Every visitor and participant must have a valid entry ticket in the form of our event wristbands (pre-sale: switch e-tickets at the gate). These must be worn visibly and they will be checked by security staff during the event. Extra tickets can be acquired online prior to the event, at the gates, or at the points where one can collect the entry documents for all the trucks that are involved.

Entry documents vehicles

Vehicle entry documents consist of a sticker to be placed on the windscreen and a day pass to be handed to security staff upon entry. These documents are personal and may not be given to others. They are valid only if presented by the person they were meant for. If one chooses to pass a day pass on to another individual, this will be recorded, and will result in the banning of the persons involved of future editions of Truckstar Festival. Also, make sure that you, as the vehicle's driver, collect your documents and please bring a valid ID (driving license). It is not allowed for a passenger of a vehicle to collect the entry documents.

Please note: The vehicle sticker must be clearly visible on the windscreen of the vehicle upon entry. Also, it is mandatory to leave the sticker in place throughout the entire weekend. The vehicle sticker is only valid for vehicles which the drivers need a C-category driving license for, i.e. trucks. Other types of vehicles such as cars, vans, (also those with trailers and caravans), and buses will not be allowed onto the grounds. Trucks without stickers and day passes will be refused entry as well.

Sounding the horn

Sounding the horn(s) on approach to Truckstar Festival, upon entry, during Truckstar Festival and whilst leaving Truckstar Festival is strictly forbidden.

Parking

The process of parking up all the trucks will be supervised by members of various Dutch drivers associations. Please listen to what these people say and follow their instructions closely. Thanks to their massive 24 hour-long voluntary effort, you and everybody else can find a good parking spot, and the parking will go fast and efficiently.

Objects around the truck

It is not allowed to place tents, sofas or other objects around the car at the Paddock. Also carpets under the Truck and flags and/or banners in front of or around your truck are not allowed.



Noise

Music may be played during the following time slots:

Saturday 28 July 08:00 – 23:30 h.

Sunday 29 July 09:00 – 18:00 h.

Outside these hours, noise must be fully reduced. Please note also that on Friday, one is not allowed to produce noise. (The reason being that we have official permission to produce noise only on Saturday and Sunday).

Security

Enforcing all regulations will be done by security staff. They will be present all over the grounds throughout the weekend. These people are there to guarantee your safety and will only act if necessary. Please always follow and respect the instructions of the security staff.

Red card system

Our red card system will be in place in 2022 as well, and works as follows:

- 1 – With the first violation, security staff will issue an official warning and fill out a violation form.
- 2 – With the second violation, a red card will be issued and a second violation form will be filled out.
- 3 – Any violation committed after the issuing of a red card will result in expulsion from Truckstar Festival and exclusion/banning from future editions of Truckstar Festival. Also, one's employer will be notified of one's behavior.

If one fails to cooperate with the expulsion, security staff will depend on the local police force to deport the offender.

The most likely reasons for receiving a red card are:

- Excessive noise (sounding horns, sound installations, etc.)
- Throwing or spraying water onto the public, security staff, etc. (including emptying entire tank trailers)
- Threatening to do harm to the public, security and event staff, or anyone else.
- Not following the instructions of security, event, or TT Circuit staff
- Hoisting people up in cranes or boom lifts
- Open fire/fireworks
- Operating motorized vehicles
- Unwanted behavior

Apprehension and transfer to the police

In cases of violent acts, threats to others, arson, destroying property, possession of drugs, drugs trading and theft, offenders will be apprehended and handed over to the police. The offender's employer will be notified at that time. In addition, the offender will be banned from Truckstar Festival in the future.



Driving ban

During the event, it is strictly forbidden to drive a truck on the grounds, unless one has explicit permission and the vehicle is guided by event staff. On Sunday, the gates will open at 16:30 h. From that moment onwards, one is allowed to drive trucks again, in order to make one's way to the exit, as instructed by security, event and TT Circuit staff. **There will be no exceptions to leave earlier than 16:30 hour.**

Transportation means

Any motorized means of transportation (quads, scooters, motorbikes, mini motorbikes, mopeds, etc.), is banned during the event. If used, these will be confiscated for the duration of the event. The use of bicycles is of course allowed.

Drones

Flying with drones is forbidden during the event. If used, these will be confiscated for the duration of the event.

Open fire

Open fire is strictly forbidden. Barbecues however are allowed, provided they will not be in direct contact with the asphalt of the race track. Also, fire extinguishers must be (visibly) present.

Sale of products, drinks, food

The sale of products, drinks and food of others is illegal. Any form of trade is illegal, except by those with permission in designated areas.

Waste

Small amounts of waste may be left behind, if bagged. Large pieces of waste must be taken back.

Picnic tables

On site we put down picnic tables. We do this for you and the visitors. We therefore ask you to leave the tables and do not move them for your own use.

Emergency services and emergency phone number

The emergency services, (fire department, ambulance, police), can be alerted by calling the security central command post at: +31 592 – 380 351. (The national emergency number in the Netherlands is 112).

Please always give way to emergency services and their crews!

Emergencies

Please check the back of this sheet to find which particular sector the emergency has taken place in and provide this information to the security staff or to first responders. The sectors are also indicated on signs attached to the guard rails around the race track, (in front of the embankments).
