

Regulations Truckstar Campsite 2023

The Profile Truckstar Festival is Europe's largest transport festival and is characterised by its conviviality and unique atmosphere. This year, visitors can spend the night at the Truckstar Campsite for the first time. Naturally, the fun is meant to be here too. So make it a fantastic weekend, for yourself and all the other guests. Read the regulations below carefully, and stick to them.

Own risk

Access to the TT Circuit and Truckstar Camping is entirely at your own risk. Truckstar, the TT Circuit and Eventcamping are never liable for any damage to vehicles, persons or goods.

Proof of identity

Valid proof of identity is compulsory. Visitors may be asked to show proof of identity with a photo and age upon entry. Failure to produce valid proof of identity will result in irrevocable denial of access to the campsite.

Entry tickets for persons (wristbands)

Every visitor is obliged to have a valid admission ticket and to wear it visibly on his/her wrist. This includes both a wristband for the campsite and for the festival itself. This will be strictly controlled. Additional wristbands can be purchased in presale or at the TT Circuit.

Sanitary facilities

Sanitary facilities are cleaned 24/7 and can be found next to reception. Wild urination is strictly prohibited.

Lockers

Lockers are available in which phones can be charged. Keys for the lockers can be collected at reception. Please return the keys when the phone has been charged so that other campsite guests also have a chance to do so.

Catering

A catering point is available where snacks and drinks can be obtained for a fee. Drinks will not be sold to under-18s.

Sound

Cosy music may be played in the following time slots:

Saturday 29 July: 08.00 a.m. to 11.30 p.m.

Sunday 30 July: 09 a.m. to 6 p.m.

Outside these times, sound sources must be switched off. On Friday and Saturday from 11.30 p.m. onwards, it is therefore not allowed to produce noise. This will be strictly controlled. From 00:00 a.m. onwards, there must be complete silence on the campsite.

Security

Compliance with the regulations will be enforced by security. Security guards will be present in every sector of the TT Circuit and Truckstar Camping throughout the weekend. They are there for your own safety and will only act if necessary. Please follow the instructions of security at all times!



Arrest and transfer to police

In case of threat, assault, arson, vandalism, drug possession, drug trafficking and theft, arrest and transfer to police will be made immediately.

Drones

It is not allowed to fly drones on and around the Profile Truckstar Festival grounds and campsite. If used, they will be confiscated for the entire duration of the event. Please consider the safety of all visitors!

Open fire

Open fire is strictly prohibited. Only gas barbecues are allowed.

Waste

During your stay at the Truckstar Campsite, we ask our guests to keep the site as tidy as possible. Please dispose of your waste in the waste bins provided. This is how we keep the stay pleasant for all guests. On departure, we also ask you to dispose of all waste.

Leaving behind sofas, bicycles and other bulky waste will result in a charge of €200 per object.

Dogs

Dogs are allowed on the campsite. However, they are not allowed to spend the night in the equipped tents we offer. This is therefore only possible in your own tent or camper. We also ask you to keep your dog on a lead and clean up any faeces.
